Many students became life-long friends and would often tell her of the appreciation they had for the life lessons she provided. Her only bequeath was to establish this scholarship for graduates of Chaparral High School. The hope was to encourage those pursuing a degree in Language Arts and/or Education.

- Harper County Community Foundation will notify the Counselor's office of how many awards may be given each year.
- Awardees must meet the eligibility requirements and will receive the amount of \$1000.
- Priority will be given to students pursuing a degree in Language Arts; teaching, writing, acting, etc.

- Be a graduate in good standing from Chaparral High School
- Be intent on attending in person or virtually a post-secondary vocational, community college, college and or university
